9 and designating March 5th, 2024, as Susan G. Komen

14 disease; and

15 WHEREAS, more than 4 million breast cancer survivors in the
16 U.S., those living with the disease and the people who love them can
17 attest to the urgent need of access to timely, affordable health
18 care - including genetic testing, screening, diagnosis and
19 treatment; and

20 WHEREAS, Susan G. Komen's vision is a world without breast
21 cancer; and

22 WHEREAS, Susan G. Komen's mission is to save lives by meeting
23 the most critical needs in our communities and investing in
24 breakthrough research to prevent and cure breast cancer; and

1 WHEREAS, Susan G. Komen honors the life and legacy of the
2 Honorable Eileen Echols annually through the Honorable Eileen Echols
3 Inspire award at the Oklahoma City Pink Tie Ball, to be held this
4 year on Saturday, April 20, 2024.
