12 WHEREAS, the Council of State Governments Southern Office
13 (CSG South) is a nonpartisan, nonprofit member organization that
14 serves the southern legislatures of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida,
15 Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, North
16 Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia,
17 and West Virginia; and

18 WHEREAS, with regionally based state leadership and
19 perspective, and national-level resources, CSG South provides
20 southern legislators and government staff with a wide variety of
21 programs and services that facilitate regional cooperation and
22 encourage the exchange of information; and

23 WHEREAS, in pursuit of this mission, CSG South has convened
24 the Southern Legislative Conference (SLC) for the past 77 years,

1 with decades of fellowship and cooperation between the Southern
2 states, the 78th Southern Legislative Conference will convene in
3 White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia at The Greenbrier from July
4 21-25, 2024; and

5 WHEREAS, more than 1,500 Southern legislators, government
6 staff, and their families will gather to discuss policy matters
7 specifically affecting Southern states to bridge commonalities
8 and discuss solutions for current policy trends, challenges, and
9 opportunities.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
11 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
