9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;
10 amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, which relates to
11 violations of transportation of live cervidae; and
12 removing certain prohibition.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 6-507, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 6-507. ~~A.~~ It shall be unlawful and a violation of the
17 Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act for any person:

18 1. To refuse an inspection authorized by the Oklahoma Farmed
19 Cervidae Act;

20 2. To commingle or integrate any native cervidae into a farmed
21 cervidae herd;

22 3. To intentionally commingle or integrate any farmed cervidae
23 with native cervidae;

24 4. To fail to maintain records as required by law;

1 5. To fail to maintain fencing as required by law;

2 6. To fail to pay any fee, fine, or penalty as required and
3 established pursuant to the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act;

4 7. To fail to comply with any State Board of Agriculture order;
5 or

6 8. To violate any provision of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae
7 Act.

8 ~~B. No person shall transport live cervidae into or through~~
9 ~~Oklahoma unless the cervidae originate from a state that allows~~
10 ~~transport of live cervidae from Oklahoma into or through that state.~~
