14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-140a of Title 47, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Department of Public Safety shall establish and
19	administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced
20	Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The purpose
21	of this program is to increase the number of peace officers
22	qualified to conduct certain drug-impairment screening tests during
23	impaired driving investigations.

1	B. The Department is authorized to provide funding, administer
2	the program, and establish grant criteria regarding the
3	administration of the program.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
