

1 expire on June 30. All vacancies and unexpired terms shall be
2 filled in the same manner as the original appointment and within
3 sixty (60) days from the date of the vacancy. Members may be
4 removed by the Governor for incompetence, willful neglect of duty,
5 corruption in office, or malfeasance in office.

6 B. Members appointed to the Commission shall reside in this
7 state and shall have the following qualifications:

8 1. Two members shall have experience as a professional
9 combative sports practitioner, other than as a professional wrestler
10 or in professional combative sports promotions;

11 2. One member shall have experience as a professional wrestler
12 or in professional wrestling promotions;

13 3. One member shall have experience in sports medicine;

14 4. One member shall have experience in the cable television
15 business; and

16 5. Four members shall represent the public at large as lay
17 members.

18 C. No member of the Commission or any person related to a
19 member within the third degree by consanguinity or affinity shall
20 promote, sponsor, or have any financial interest in the promotion or
21 sponsorship of any professional combative sports event or amateur
22 mixed martial arts event while a member of the Commission.

23 D. The members of the Commission shall elect from their
24 membership a chair and vice-chair to serve for one-year terms. A

1 majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of
2 conducting the business of the Commission. The Commission shall
3 meet at least quarterly, and special meetings may be called by the
4 chair.

5 E. The Commission shall comply with the provisions of the
6 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act, the Oklahoma Open Records Act, and the
7 Administrative Procedures Act.

8 F. All members of the Commission and such employees as
9 determined by the Commission shall be bonded as required by Sections
10 85.58Q through 85.58V of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

11 G. Members of the Commission shall serve without compensation
12 but shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of
13 their duties as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
