12 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
13 authorizing creation and administration of certain
14 pilot program; providing for codification; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-140a of Title 47, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Department of Public Safety shall establish and
21 administer a pilot program to increase the availability of Advanced
22 Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE) training. The purpose
23 of this program is to increase the number of peace officers

1 qualified to conduct certain drug-impairment screening tests during
2 impaired driving investigations.

3 B. The Department is authorized to provide funding, administer
4 the program, and establish grant criteria regarding the
5 administration of the program.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
