12	An Act relating to state department vehicle fleets; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 156, as last amended
13	by Section 1, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 156), which relates to the purchase of
14	vehicles with public funds; adding Department of Environmental Quality to certain list of exemptions;
15	updating statutory references; updating statutory language; and providing an effective date.

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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 156, as last
22	amended by Section 1, Chapter 272, O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023,
23	Section 156), is amended to read as follows:

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1	Section 156. A. Unless otherwise provided for by law, no state
2	board, commission, department, institution, official, or employee,
3	except the following, shall purchase any passenger automobile or bus
4	with public funds:
5	1. The Department of Public Safety;
6	2. The Department of Human Services;
7	3. The State Department of Rehabilitation Services;
8	4. The Department of Wildlife Conservation;
9	5. The Department of Corrections;
10	6. The State Department of Education;
11	7. The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics;
12	8. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
13	Control;
14	9. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation;
15	10. The Transportation Commission;
16	11. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry;
17	12. The State Department of Health;
18	13. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
19	Services;
20	14. The J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental
21	Disabilities;
22	15. The Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;
23	16. The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department;
24	17. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission;

1	18. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board;
2	19. The Department of Mines;
3	20. The Office of Juvenile Affairs;
4	21. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs;
5	22. The <del>Oklahoma</del> Supreme Court;
6	23. The District Attorneys Council and Oklahoma district
7	attorneys, provided adequate funding exists;
8	24. The Oklahoma Boll Weevil Eradication Organization;
9	25. The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission; and
10	26. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training; and
11	27. The Department of Environmental Quality.
12	B. 1. The Oklahoma School for the Deaf at Sulphur, the
13	Oklahoma School for the Blind at Muskogee, and any state institution
14	of higher education may purchase, own, or keep if now owned, or
15	acquire by lease or gift, and use and maintain such station wagons,
16	automobiles, trucks, or buses as are reasonably necessary for the
17	implementation of the educational programs of said such
18	institutions.
19	2. No bus operated, owned, or used by such educational
20	institutions shall be permitted to carry any person other than

20 institutions shall be permitted to carry any person other than 21 students, faculty members, employees, or volunteers of such 22 institutions. The provisions of this section shall not be construed 23 to prohibit:

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- 1a. the operation of intracampus buses or buses routed2directly between portions of the campus of any3institution not adjacent to each other, nor to4prohibit the collection of fares from such students,5faculty members, or employees of such institutions,6sufficient in amount to cover the reasonable cost of7such transportation, or
- b. the Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma 8 9 School for the Deaf from entering into agreements with 10 local public school districts pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act for the mutual use of the 11 schools' and the districts' vehicles. 12 Such use may 13 include, but is not limited to, the transportation of students from local school districts with students 14 from the Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma 15 School for the Deaf in vehicles owned by the Oklahoma 16 School for the Blind or the Oklahoma School for the 17 Deaf when traveling to school-related activities. 18 The J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental 19 С. Disabilities, the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, the Oklahoma 20 Department of Veterans Affairs, and the Oklahoma Veterans Centers 21 State Veterans Homes may own and maintain such passenger vehicles as 22 those institutions have acquired prior to May 1, 1981. 23
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1 D. The use of station wagons, automobiles, and buses, other 2 than as provided for in this section, shall be permitted only upon written request for such use by heads of departments of the 3 institution, approved in writing by the president of said such 4 5 institution or by some administrative official of said such 6 institution authorized by the president to grant said the approval. Such use shall be permitted only for official institutional business 7 or activities connected therewith. Such use shall be subject to the 8 9 provisions of Section 156.1 of this title forbidding personal use of 10 such vehicles, and to the penalties therein declared.

E. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by fine or imprisonment, or both, as provided for in Section 156.1 of this title.

F. For the purpose of this section and Section 156.3 of this 15 title, a station wagon is classified as a passenger automobile and 16 may not be purchased solely for the use of transporting property. 17 Such vehicles shall include, but not be limited to, all vehicles 18 which have no separate luggage compartment or trunk but which do not 19 20 have open beds, whether the same are called station wagons, vans, suburbans, town and country, blazers, or any other names. All state 21 boards, commissions, departments, and institutions may own and 22 maintain station wagons purchased solely for the purpose of 23 transporting property if acquired prior to July 1, 1985. 24

1	G. The provisions of this section and Section 156.1 of this
2	title shall not apply to public officials who are statewide elected
3	commissioners.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
