9 An Act relating to Oklahoma Uniform Building Code
10 Commission; prohibiting any provision from being
11 enacted to prohibit or limit use of refrigerant
12 designated as federally acceptable; requiring
13 installation of certain equipment to maintain certain
14 standards and conditions; providing for codification;
15 and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.30 of Title 59, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 No provision of a building code, any other law, regulation, or
21 other requirement in Oklahoma may prohibit or otherwise limit the
22 use of a refrigerant designated as acceptable for use pursuant to
23 and in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 7671K; provided, any equipment
24 containing such refrigerant is listed and installed in accordance

1 with safety standards and use conditions imposed pursuant to such
2 designation.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
