NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1000.30 of Title 59, unless 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 No provision of a building code, any other law, regulation, or 19 other requirement in Oklahoma may prohibit or otherwise limit the 20 use of a refrigerant designated as acceptable for use pursuant to 21 and in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 7671K; provided, any equipment 22 containing such refrigerant is listed and installed in accordance 23 24

3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
