10	An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. Section 2021, Section 1438, which relates to
11	penalties for unlawful entry without permission; making certain acts unlawful; providing penalties;

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1438, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1438. A. Every person who, under circumstances not
19	amounting to any burglary, enters any building or part of any
20	building, booth, tent, warehouse, railroad car, vessel, or other
21	structure or erection with intent to commit any felony, larceny, or
22	malicious mischief, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
23	B. Every person who, without the intention to commit any crime
24	therein, shall willfully and intentionally break and enter into any

1 building, trailer, vessel or other premises used as a dw
--

- 2 | without the permission of the owner or occupant thereof, except in
- 3 | the cases and manner allowed by law, shall be guilty of a
- 4 misdemeanor.
- 5 <u>C. Every person who, with the intent to commit a crime, enters</u>
- 6 an area of a commercial business that is:
- 7 1. Commonly reserved for personnel of the commercial business
- 8 where money or other property is kept; or
- 9 2. Clearly marked with a sign or signs that indicates to the
- 10 public that entry is forbidden,
- 11 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 12 imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than one (1)
- 13 year, or a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
- 14 by both such fine and imprisonment. Any second or subsequent
- 15 conviction under the provisions of this subsection shall be a felony
- 16 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of
- Corrections for a term of not more than two (2) years, or by a fine
- of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such
- 19 <u>fine and imprisonment.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
