9 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021,
10 Section 5-130, which relates to use of school
11 buildings and properties; allowing a school district
12 board of education to enter into an agreement with a
13 church for use of certain building or property for
14 certain purposes; providing an effective date; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 5-130, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 5-130. A. The board of education of any school
20 district may, under such regulations and conditions as it may
21 prescribe, encourage increased community involvement in the public
22 schools. These regulations and conditions may include:

23 1. Open any school building and permit the use of any property
24 belonging to such district for religious, political, literary,
 community, cultural, scientific, mechanical, agricultural, or

1 parental involvement purposes, and other purposes of general public
2 interest including the provision of public library services pursuant
3 to agreements with governing boards or commissions of public
4 libraries or library systems;

5 2. Contract to provide transportation equipment as defined in
6 Section 9-104 of this title for any purpose specified in paragraph 1
7 of this subsection; and

8 3. Make a reasonable charge to cover the cost of the use of
9 such building, property, or transportation equipment.

10 B. The State Board of Education shall encourage each board of
11 education to inquire into and promote the use of its school
12 buildings and property for the purposes provided in subsection A of
13 this section for such activities both before and after regular
14 school hours.

15 C. Any youth group listed in Title 36 of the United States Code
16 as a patriotic society shall be allowed the use of any school
17 building or property to provide services allowing students to
18 participate in activities provided by the groups at times other than
19 instructional time during the school day.

20 D. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a school district
21 board of education from entering into an agreement with a church to
22 utilize a church building or any property belonging to such church
23 for political, literary, community, cultural, scientific,
24 mechanical, agricultural, or parental involvement purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
