9       An Act relating to district courts; amending 20 O.S.  
10      2021, Section 91.2, which relates to dockets;  
11      clarifying judge required to establish drug court  
12      docket; and providing an effective date.

13   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14       SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       20 O.S. 2021, Section 91.2, is  
15      amended to read as follows:

16       Section 91.2.   A.   To facilitate the trial and disposition of  
17      cases, actions filed in the district court shall be assigned to  
18      various dockets by the clerk of the court pursuant to the direction  
19      and supervision of the presiding judge of the district.   Until  
20      changed by order of the Supreme Court, only the following dockets  
21      are established: a civil docket, a criminal docket, a traffic  
22      docket, a probate docket, a juvenile and family relations docket, a  
23      small claims docket, and a business docket for business court  
24      divisions of the court created pursuant to Section 17 of this act.

1       B. Whenever a district court establishes a drug court program  
2 pursuant to the provisions of Sections 471 through 471.11 of Title  
3 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the judge ~~having authority~~ presiding  
4 over the program shall cause to be established a drug court docket.  
5 In those cases assigned to the drug court docket, the judge shall  
6 determine what information or pleadings are to be maintained in a  
7 confidential case file which shall be closed to public inspection.  
8 The originating criminal case file shall remain open to public  
9 inspection. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the district  
10 attorney, defense attorney, or the victim-witness coordinator from  
11 advising any victim or other person regarding the assignment or  
12 disposition of a drug court case.

13       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
