9 An Act relating to Oklahoma Petroleum Storage Tank
10 Consolidation Act; amending 17 O.S. 2021, Section
11 347, which relates to ethanol or methanol labeling;
12 requiring motor fuel with certain amount of ethanol
13 be labeled pursuant to federal requirements; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2021, Section 347, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 347. A. No person shall sell or offer for sale motor
19 fuel from a motor fuel dispenser supplied by a storage tank into
20 which motor fuel that contains a mixture of at least one percent
21 (1%) by volume of ethanol or methanol has been delivered within the
22 sixty-day period preceding the date of sale or offer of sale unless
23 the person prominently displays on the dispenser from which the
24 mixture is sold a label that complies with subsection B of this
 section.

1 B. 1. A label as required in subsection A of this section
2 shall:

3 ~~1.—Be~~ a. be displayed on each face of the motor fuel
4 dispenser on which the price of the motor fuel mixture
5 sold from the dispenser is displayed~~†,~~

6 ~~2.—State~~ b. state "Contains Ethanol" or "Contains
7 Methanol", as applicable~~†,~~

8 ~~3.—Appear~~ c. appear in contrasting colors with block
9 letters at least one-half (1/2) inch high and one-
10 fourth (1/4) inch wide~~†,~~ and

11 ~~4.—Be~~ d. be displayed in a clear, conspicuous and
12 prominent manner, visible to customers using either
13 side of the dispenser.

14 2. If the motor fuel contains fifteen percent (15%) ethanol, a
15 pump label as required in subsection A of this section shall meet
16 federal E15 labeling requirements as ruled by the Environmental
17 Protection Agency pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1090.1510 as it is written
18 on February 1, 2023.

19 C. If a motor fuel dispenser is supplied by a storage tank into
20 which motor fuel containing at least ten percent (10%) ethanol by
21 volume or at least five percent (5%) methanol by volume is delivered
22 in the sixty-day period preceding the date of the sale or offer of
23 sale, the sign as required in subsection A of this section shall
24 also state the percentage of ethanol or methanol by volume, to the

1 nearest whole percent, of the motor fuel having the highest
2 percentage of ethanol or methanol delivered into that storage tank
3 during that period.

4 D. On request by a motor fuel user, a person selling or
5 offering for sale motor fuel from a motor fuel dispenser shall
6 reveal:

7 1. The percentage of ethanol contained in the motor fuel being
8 sold;

9 2. The percentage of methanol contained in the motor fuel being
10 sold; and

11 3. If the motor fuel contains methanol, the types and
12 percentages of associated cosolvents contained in the motor fuel
13 being sold.

14 E. The provisions of this section shall not prohibit the
15 posting of any other alcohol or additive information. Other alcohol
16 or additive information and any relevant posting shall be subject to
17 regulation by the Corporation Commission.

18 F. The Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules as
19 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
