11           An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge  
12           designations; designating the Army SPC Ryan J. Grady  
13           Memorial Highway; designating the First MCPON Delbert  
14           D. Black, U.S. Navy, Memorial Highway; designating  
15           the Captain William "Willy" Hargraves Memorial  
16           Intersection; designating the Trooper Larry L.  
17           Hillyard Memorial Bridge; designating the C.D.  
18           Scribner WWII Veteran Memorial Highway; designating  
19           the LCpl Nelson Matlock Memorial Highway; providing  
20           for codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22           SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
23           in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.398 of Title 69, unless  
24           there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

          The section of State Highway 66 beginning at the intersection of  
Country Club Road on the southwest edge of Bristow extending

1 northeasterly to the intersection of West 3rd Avenue in Creek County  
2 shall be designated as the "Army SPC Ryan J. Grady Memorial  
3 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
4 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.399 of Title 69, unless  
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of Interstate 35 beginning on the south side of the  
9 State Highway 32 interchange extending north approximately seven (7)  
10 miles to the north side of the Oswalt Road interchange in Love  
11 County shall be designated as the "First MCPON Delbert D. Black,  
12 U.S. Navy, Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation  
13 shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be placed on the  
14 highway.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.400 of Title 69, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The intersection of U.S. Highway 60 and State Highway 18 north  
19 of Fairfax in Osage County shall be designated as the "Captain  
20 William 'Willy' Hargraves Memorial Intersection". The Department of  
21 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be  
22 placed at the intersection.

1       SECTION 4.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.401 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4       The bridge crossing over Polecat Creek on U.S. Highway 75A south  
5 of Sapulpa in Creek County shall be designated as the "Trooper Larry  
6 L. Hillyard Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation  
7 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be  
8 placed on the bridge.

9       SECTION 5.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.402 of Title 69, unless  
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12       The section of State Highway 48A beginning at the intersection  
13 of Hollow Springs Road, extending east to the intersection of SH-48  
14 in Coleman in Johnston County shall be designated as the "C.D.  
15 Scribner WWII Veteran Memorial Highway". The Department of  
16 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
17 name to be placed on the highway.

18       SECTION 6.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.403 of Title 69, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21       The section of State Highway 66 beginning at the intersection of  
22 Flynn Avenue in Depew extending east to the intersection of South  
23 433rd W Avenue in Creek County shall be designated as the "LCpl  
24 Nelson Matlock Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation

1 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be  
2 placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
