11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2021, Sections 1135.2, as amended by Section 2,
13 Chapter 397, and 1135.3, as amended by Section 162,
14 Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
15 Sections 1135.2 and 1135.3), which relate to special
16 license plates; authorizing the Meritorious Service
17 Medal license plate, ROAD license plate, the Tulsa
18 Icon license plate, and the ORA license plate to be
19 issued; updating statutory language; and providing an
20 effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.2, as
23 amended by Section 2, Chapter 397, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
24 Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:

 Section 1135.2 A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to
design and issue appropriate official special license plates to

1 persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by
2 this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service
9 Oklahoma or a licensed operator. Service Oklahoma shall annually
10 notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The
11 notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a
13 licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
15 amateur radio operator license plates.

16 Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a
17 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept
18 applications for special license plates authorized under this
19 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's
20 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
21 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
22 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
23 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators
24 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for

1 registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for
2 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
3 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1,
4 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and
5 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
6 Fund.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
8 follows:

9 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
11 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
12 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
13 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
14 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
15 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
16 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
17 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
18 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
19 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
20 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
21 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
22 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
23 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

24

1 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
3 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
4 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
5 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

6 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
8 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
9 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
10 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

11 4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of
13 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of
14 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air
15 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to
16 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have
17 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
18 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present
19 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services
20 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form
21 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates
22 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but
23 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually;
24

1 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
3 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
4 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
5 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

6 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

7 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
9 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
10 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
11 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
12 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
13 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
14 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
15 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
16 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
17 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
18 of one (1) ton or less;

19 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
21 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
22 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
23 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
24 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate

1 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
2 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
3 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
4 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
5 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
7 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
8 provided by this section for special license plates;

9 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
11 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
12 the United States as being:

- 13 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
14 7, 1941,
- 15 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
16 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
17 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
18 exceed three (3) miles, and
- 19 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
20 States Armed Forces.

21 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
22 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
23 less;
24

1 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
2 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
3 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
4 States as being:

- 5 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
6 of 1945,
- 7 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
8 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 9 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
10 States Armed Forces.

11 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
12 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

13 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
14 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
15 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
16 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
17 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
18 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
19 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
20 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
21 registration after the initial issue;

22 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
24

1 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States as being:

3 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
4 1944,

5 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
6 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
7 participation cannot be verified by the United States
8 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
9 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
10 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
11 the person applying for the license plate, and

12 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
13 States Armed Forces.

14 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
15 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

16 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
18 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
19 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
20 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
21 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
22 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
23 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
24 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two

1 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
2 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
4 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Beginning November 1,
6 2021, the killed in action license plate shall be designed to honor
7 members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action
8 while engaged in combat with a hostile force. The parents,
9 siblings, half-siblings, grandparents or spouse of the deceased
10 person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the
11 remarriage is terminated by death, divorce or annulment, may apply
12 for a killed in action license plate upon presenting proper
13 certification that the person was killed in action and that the
14 person making the application is the qualifying spouse or family
15 member of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse or family
16 member may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more
17 than two vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
18 of one (1) ton or less. The license plate shall have a white
19 background and the legend "Killed in Action" and shall contain any
20 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven in
21 black, as for personalized license plates. To the left of the
22 numbers and letters shall be the Battlefield Cross in gold. The
23 killed in action license plate shall be exempt from any minimum
24 issuance criteria related to license plate applications;

1 12. Gold Star Families License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
3 killed while on active duty. The parents, siblings, half-siblings
4 or grandparents of the deceased person may apply for a gold star
5 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
6 was killed while on active duty and that the person making the
7 application is the parent, sibling, half-sibling or grandparent of
8 the deceased person. The family member may apply for a gold star
9 families license plate for no more than two vehicles with each
10 vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
11 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
12 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
13 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
14 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

15 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
17 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
18 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
19 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
20 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such

1 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
2 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal
5 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
6 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
7 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
8 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
9 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
10 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
11 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
12 education police department by either an identification card or
13 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
14 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
15 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
16 application but shall not be required to provide proof of
17 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
19 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
20 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
21 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

22 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
24 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be

1 verified by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the
2 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
3 States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the
4 period from September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former
5 members may apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for
6 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
8 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
11 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
12 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
13 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
14 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
15 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
16 "WORLD WAR II";

17 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
19 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
20 verified by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the
21 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
22 States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the
23 period from June 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates
24 inclusive. The former members may apply for a Korean War Veteran

1 license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
2 ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
7 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
8 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
9 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
10 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
11 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

12 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
14 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
15 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
16 be produced upon application;

17 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
18 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
19 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
20 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
21 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
22 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
23 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
24 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and

1 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
2 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
3 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
4 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
5 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
6 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

7 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
9 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
10 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
11 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
15 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
16 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
17 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
19 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
20 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
21 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

22 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
24 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
2 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
3 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

4 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
5 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
6 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
7 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
8 the Ninety-Nines;

9 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
11 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
12 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
13 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
14 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
15 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
16 less;

17 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
19 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
20 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
21 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of

1 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
2 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
3 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

4 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
6 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
7 United States Secretary of Defense;

8 29. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by
10 the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
11 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
12 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
13 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
14 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
16 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
17 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
18 district number;

19 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United
21 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
22 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
23 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
24 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been

1 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
2 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
3 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
4 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
5 may apply to Service Oklahoma for a disabled veterans license plate
6 or to a licensed operator for a regular license plate for no more
7 than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity
8 of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased
9 disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if
10 remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
11 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
12 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
13 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
14 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
15 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
16 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
17 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
18 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
19 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

20 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
21 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
22 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
23 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
24 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized

1 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
2 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
3 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
4 Service Oklahoma;

5 32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
6 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
7 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
8 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Association;

10 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
12 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
13 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
14 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
15 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
16 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
17 Academy;

18 34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's
20 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
21 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
22 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
23 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
24 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle

1 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
2 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by Service
3 Oklahoma and the plates issued to such applicant shall have stamped
4 thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call letters of
5 the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission
6 to the individual amateur operator thereof. All applications for
7 such plates must be made to Service Oklahoma on or before the first
8 day of October of any year for such plates for the following
9 calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee required in this
10 section together with a certificate, or such other evidence as
11 Service Oklahoma may require, of proof that applicant has a valid
12 technician class or better amateur operator's license and proof of
13 applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio receiving and
14 transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall only be
15 entitled to one set of special identification plates in any one (1)
16 year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The right to
17 such special identification plates herein provided for shall
18 continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the person to
19 whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

20 35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
22 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
24 Oklahoma;

1 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
3 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
4 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
6 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
7 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
8 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
10 eligibility upon initial application but shall not be required to
11 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
13 state;

14 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
16 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
17 shall mean:

- 18 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
19 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
20 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
21 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
22 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
23 while on active military duty, or
24

1 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
2 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
3 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
4 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
5 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
6 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
7 discharge of such person.

8 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
9 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
10 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
11 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

12 38. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
14 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
15 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
16 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
17 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 39. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.
20 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide
21 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
22 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
23 Infantry;

1 40. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
3 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
4 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
5 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
6 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle;
7 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
8 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
9 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

10 41. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
12 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
13 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
14 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
15 (1) ton or less;

16 42. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
18 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
19 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
21 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
22 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a
24 motorcycle; provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of

1 similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a
2 new design in order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle
3 license plate;

4 43. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
6 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
7 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
8 section. Service Oklahoma shall develop and implement a system
9 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
10 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
11 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
12 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

13 44. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
15 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
16 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
17 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
18 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
19 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
20 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
21 (1) ton or less;

22 45. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
23 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
24 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans

1 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
2 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
3 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient
4 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
5 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

7 46. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
8 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
9 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
10 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
11 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

13 47. 2-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
14 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
15 former member of the 2-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
16 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
17 association with the 2-179th Infantry Association. The license
18 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 2-179th Infantry;

19 48. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
21 who present proper certification from the United States Department
22 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
23 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat

1 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
2 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 49. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
5 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
6 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
7 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
8 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
9 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
10 represent both officer and enlisted service members;

11 50. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
12 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
13 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
14 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
15 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
16 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
17 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
18 Department of the State of Oklahoma;

19 51. Combat Action Badge Recipient License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Badge who
21 present proper certification from the United States Army. The
22 license plate shall include the Combat Action Badge earned by the
23 recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat Action Badge
24 Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
2 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
3 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
4 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

5 52. Iraq Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
7 the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation Iraqi
8 Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Iraq Combat Veteran license
9 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
10 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for
11 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
12 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
13 for a motorcycle license plate;

14 53. Afghanistan Combat Veteran License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present
16 member of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in Operation
17 Enduring Freedom. Such persons may apply for an Afghanistan Combat
18 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
19 capacity of one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the
20 license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the
21 license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to
22 meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

23 54. Special Forces Association License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present

1 member of the Army Special Forces qualified and authorized to wear
2 upon the person's United States military uniform the Army Special
3 Forces Tab. Persons applying for the Special Forces Association
4 license plate must provide a copy of the orders awarding the Special
5 Forces Tab or authorizing its wear upon a United States military
6 uniform. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
7 the Special Forces Association, Chapter 32-50. Service Oklahoma
8 shall produce up to two distinct designs for the Special Forces
9 Association license plate. Qualified persons may select one design
10 at the time of application. The plates shall be issued to any
11 qualified person in any combination of numbers and letters from one
12 to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

13 55. Veterans of the United States Armed Forces License Plates -
14 such plates shall be designed for veterans of the United States
15 Armed Forces, and shall identify the branch of service, carry the
16 emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
17 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
18 belonged, and shall reflect veteran status. Former members who have
19 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates.
20 Persons applying for such license plates must show proof of past
21 military service by presenting a valid United States Department of
22 Defense Form (DD)214 upon initial application but shall not be
23 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

1 56. Navy Chief License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to any resident of this state who has achieved the rank
3 of E7 through E9 in the United States Navy and presents proper
4 certification that the resident has achieved such rank and was
5 either honorably discharged or is an active or retired member of the
6 United States Navy. Such persons may apply for a Navy Chief license
7 plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
8 or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate for
9 motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor
10 vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space requirements
11 for a motorcycle license plate; ~~and~~

12 57. Air Medal License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
13 issued to any resident of this state who has earned the Air Medal
14 and presents proper certification that the resident has been awarded
15 such medal. The license plate shall include an image of the Air
16 Medal earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for an Air
17 Medal license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of
18 one (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license
19 plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate
20 for motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space
21 requirements for a motorcycle license plate; and

22 58. Meritorious Service Medal License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has earned
24 the Meritorious Service Medal and presents proper certification that

1 the resident has been awarded such medal. The license plate shall
2 include an image of the Meritorious Service Medal earned by the
3 recipient. Such persons may apply for an Meritorious Service Medal
4 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
5 (1) ton or less, or for a motorcycle; provided, the license plate
6 for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for
7 motor vehicles or may be a new design in order to meet space
8 requirements for a motorcycle license plate.

9 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
10 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
11 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
12 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
13 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
14 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Beginning
15 January 1, 2023, such fees shall be deposited in the Service
16 Oklahoma Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the
17 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.3, as
19 amended by Section 162, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp.
20 2022, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1135.3 A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to
22 design and issue appropriate official special license plates to
23 persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest or membership to or
24

1 for an organization, occupation, cause or other subject as provided
2 by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service
9 Oklahoma or a licensed operator, unless authorized by Service
10 Oklahoma to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.
11 Service Oklahoma shall notify by mail all persons issued special
12 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information
13 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon
14 presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The
15 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

16 Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a
17 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept
18 applications for special license plates authorized under this
19 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's
20 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
21 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
22 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
23 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators
24 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for

1 registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for
2 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
3 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1,
4 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and
5 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
6 Fund.

7 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
8 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
9 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
11 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
13 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
14 removed from the vehicle.

15 Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates
16 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall
17 be developed or issued by Service Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma
18 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. The
19 prepaid applications must be received by Service Oklahoma within one
20 hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization
21 or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one
22 hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by Service
23 Oklahoma within such prescribed time period any payment so received
24 shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as

17 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
19 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
20 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
21 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
23 contain the Masonic emblem;

1 5. ~~Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children~~

2 Shriners Hospitals for Children License Plate - such plates shall be
3 designed to demonstrate support for ~~Shriner's Hospitals for Burned~~
4 ~~and Crippled Children~~ Shriners Hospitals for Children and shall be
5 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a ~~Shriner's~~
6 Shriners Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
7 consultation with the ~~Shriner's~~ Shriners Temples in Oklahoma and
8 shall contain the ~~Shriner's~~ Shriners emblem;

9 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
10 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
11 ballooning in this state;

12 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
13 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
14 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
15 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
16 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
17 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
18 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
19 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
20 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
21 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

22 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
24 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of

1 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
3 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
4 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
5 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
6 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
7 Columbus emblem;

8 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
9 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
10 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
11 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

12 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
14 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
15 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with Kiwanis International;

17 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
19 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
20 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
22 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
23 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
24 Accountants;

1 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
4 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
5 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
6 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
7 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
8 emergency management department head;

9 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service
11 Oklahoma, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and issued
12 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
13 Conservation Corps;

14 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
15 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a ~~Rotarian~~
16 Rotary Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian
17 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
18 (1) ton or less upon proof of a ~~Rotarian~~ Rotary Club membership or
19 upon the presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
20 authorized and approved by a ~~Rotarian~~ Rotary Club of Oklahoma. The
21 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the five
22 Rotarian District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

23 15. Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks License Plate -
24 such plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented

1 to Service Oklahoma, by the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks,
2 and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
3 Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks;

4 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
6 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
7 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
8 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
9 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

10 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma,
12 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
13 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
14 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
15 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
16 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
17 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
18 personalized license plates;

19 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
20 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
21 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
22 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in

2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
4 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
5 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
6 Oklahoma;

7 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium. Subject to the provisions
11 of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma Aquarium license plate
12 is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2021;

13 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

23 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
24

1 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as

3 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
5 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
6 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

7 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
10 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
11 Association;

12 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
14 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
16 Sorority;

17 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
18 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
19 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
20 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
21 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
23 Incorporated;

1 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
3 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
5 of Health;

6 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
8 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
9 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
10 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

11 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
12 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
13 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community

17 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma

22 32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi

3 33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha

8 34. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
9 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
10 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System

12 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
13 Officials;

14 35. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
16 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

12 license plate is required, at the time of application, to show proof
13 he or she is a recipient of the Air Medal or sign an attestation

9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the Spirit of Oklahoma State marching band.
11 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahoma State
12 University;

13 74. Southeast Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
15 Southeast High School Spartans and such plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Southeast High School Alumni Association;

17 75. Catoosa High School License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 Catoosa High School located in Catoosa. The plates shall bear the
20 image of the Catoosa High School mascot and be designed in

20 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the

22 or any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
23 six for vehicles or one to a maximum of five for motorcycles, as for
24 personalized plates. The plate design for vehicles will include

1 Tulsa's iconic Golden Driller and Route 66 Rising sculpture. The
2 license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar design as space
3 permits or a new design in order to meet the space requirements of a
4 motorcycle license plate; and

5 86. ORA License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
6 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
7 Rifle Association. The license plates shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Rifle Association.

9 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
10 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
11 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
12 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
13 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
14 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
15 the ~~Oklahoma~~ Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
16 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
17 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the

1 renewal of the special license plate fee shall be apportioned as
2 provided in Section 1104 of this title.
