| 18 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:   |
| 19 | SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.2, as  |
| 20 | amended by Section 2, Chapter 397, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,                                       |
| 21 | Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:   |
| 22 | Section 1135.2 A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to  |
| 23 | design and issue appropriate official special license plates to   |
| 24 |   |

SB510 HFLR BOLD FACE denotes Committee Amendments. 1 persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by 2 this section.

Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service 8 9 Oklahoma or a licensed operator. Service Oklahoma shall annually 10 notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 11 12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The license plates shall be 13 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 14 amateur radio operator license plates. 15

Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 16 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 17 applications for special license plates authorized under this 18 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's 19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 24

registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for
 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1,
 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and
 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
 Fund.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as 8 follows:

9 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 11 12 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 13 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having 14 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 15 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not 16 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 17 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 18 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 19 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 23

2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates 11 12 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of 13 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air 14 Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to 15 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have 16 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. 17 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present 18 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services 19 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form 20 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates 21 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but 22 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually; 23

5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be 7 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 8 9 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 10 11 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the 12 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 13 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 14 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 15 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in 16 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 17 of one (1) ton or less; 18

Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate

1 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 2 The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been less. awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 3 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 4 5 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 6 The license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee 7 provided by this section for special license plates; 8

9 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be 10 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the 11 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 12 the United States as being:

a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
7, 1941,

b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
exceed three (3) miles, and

c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
  of 1945,
- b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
  vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and
- 9 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
  10 States Armed Forces.

Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for eachvehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall 13 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 14 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 15 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." 16 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such 17 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other 18 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 19 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 20 registration after the initial issue; 21

22 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the

- United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
   the United States as being:
- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
  1944,
- 5 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such 6 participation cannot be verified by the United States 7 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of 8 9 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its 10 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from the person applying for the license plate, and 11 12 с. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United States Armed Forces. 13

Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for 14 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 15 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 17 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 18 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 19 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 20 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 21 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 22 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 23 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 24

1 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 2 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 3 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 4 5 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Beginning November 1, 2021, the killed in action license plate shall be designed to honor 6 members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action 7 while engaged in combat with a hostile force. 8 The parents, 9 siblings, half-siblings, grandparents or spouse of the deceased 10 person, if the spouse has not remarried, or if remarried, the 11 remarriage is terminated by death, divorce or annulment, may apply 12 for a killed in action license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed in action and that the 13 person making the application is the qualifying spouse or family 14 15 member of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse or family member may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more 16 17 than two vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The license plate shall have a white 18 background and the legend "Killed in Action" and shall contain any 19 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven in 20 black, as for personalized license plates. To the left of the 21 numbers and letters shall be the Battlefield Cross in gold. 22 The killed in action license plate shall be exempt from any minimum 23 issuance criteria related to license plate applications; 24

1 12. Gold Star Families License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed while on active duty. The parents, siblings, half-siblings 3 or grandparents of the deceased person may apply for a gold star 4 5 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person was killed while on active duty and that the person making the 6 application is the parent, sibling, half-sibling or grandparent of 7 the deceased person. The family member may apply for a gold star 8 9 families license plate for no more than two vehicles with each 10 vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 11 12 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 13 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 14

15 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 17 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 18 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 19 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 20 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 21 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such

persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 3 15. designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 4 5 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 6 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council 7 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 8 9 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated 10 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 11 12 education police department by either an identification card or 13 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 14 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 15 application but shall not be required to provide proof of 16 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in 17 consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 18 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design 19 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 20 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 21 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 22 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 23 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 24

verified by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the period from September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall 7 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 8 9 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 10 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps, Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which 11 12 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at 13 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. 14 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words 15 "WORLD WAR II"; 16

17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 18 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be 19 verified by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the 20 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United 21 States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the 22 period from June 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates 23 The former members may apply for a Korean War Veteran 24 inclusive.

license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
 ton or less.

The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall 3 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia 4 5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold 6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member 7 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the 8 9 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two 10 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA"; 11

12 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and 14 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or 15 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only 16 be produced upon application;

19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be 17 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are 18 residents of this state. Such persons must present an 19 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a 20 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with 21 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend 22 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the 23 24 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and

three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

7 20. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed 8 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the 9 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and 10 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert 11 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 21. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be 14 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of 15 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may 16 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle 17 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 22. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
19 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
20 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
21 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

22 23. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
24 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate

1 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 2 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license 3 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

4 24. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
5 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
6 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety7 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
8 the Ninety-Nines;

9 25. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge. 10 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend 11 12 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge". 13 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate 14 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 15 less; 16

17 26. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall 18 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member 19 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United 20 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat 21 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying 22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 27. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of

Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

4 28. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
6 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
7 United States Secretary of Defense;

Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be 8 29. 9 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to Service Oklahoma by 10 the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any 11 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as 12 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such 13 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less; 14

15 30. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed 16 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate 17 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the 18 district number;

19 31. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be 20 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United 21 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the 22 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected 23 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which 24 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been

1 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a 2 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability 3 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons 4 5 may apply to Service Oklahoma for a disabled veterans license plate or to a licensed operator for a regular license plate for no more 6 than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity 7 of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased 8 9 disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if 10 remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and 11 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans 12 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one 13 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 14 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate 15 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other 16 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees 17 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this 18 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00). 19

If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized 1 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled 2 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the 3 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to 4 Service Oklahoma;

32. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
designed in consultation with the Association;

10 33. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state 11 12 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for 13 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 14 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 15 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the 16 Academy; 17

34. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment. Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle

1 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such 2 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by Service Oklahoma and the plates issued to such applicant shall have stamped 3 thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call letters of 4 5 the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications Commission 6 to the individual amateur operator thereof. All applications for such plates must be made to Service Oklahoma on or before the first 7 day of October of any year for such plates for the following 8 9 calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee required in this 10 section together with a certificate, or such other evidence as Service Oklahoma may require, of proof that applicant has a valid 11 12 technician class or better amateur operator's license and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio receiving and 13 transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall only be 14 entitled to one set of special identification plates in any one (1) 15 year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The right to 16 such special identification plates herein provided for shall 17 continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the person to 18 whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked; 19

35. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of membership. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of Oklahoma;

1 36. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be 2 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for 3 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or 4 5 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the 6 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which 7 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension. 8 9 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of 10 eligibility upon initial application but shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be 11 12 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this 13 state;

14 37. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates 15 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of 16 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran" 17 shall mean:

18a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the19United States Armed Forces or as a member of the20Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result21of the performance of duties for any branch of the22United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard23while on active military duty, or

b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
discharge of such person.

The 14 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system. 15

Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 16 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 17 applications for special license plates authorized under this 18 section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's 19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 24

registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for
 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1,
 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and
 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
 Fund.

If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 7 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 8 9 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license 11 12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be 13 removed from the vehicle. 14

Except as otherwise provided in law, for special license plates 15 authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special license plates shall 16 be developed or issued by Service Oklahoma until Service Oklahoma 17 receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications therefor. 18 The prepaid applications must be received by Service Oklahoma within one 19 hundred eighty (180) days of the effective date of the authorization 20 or the authority to issue shall be null and void. In the event one 21 hundred (100) prepaid applications are not received by Service 22 Oklahoma within such prescribed time period any payment so received 23 shall be refunded accordingly. 24
