AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2021, Section 114, is 15 amended to read as follows: 16 Section 114. The Oklahoma Tax Commission may expend monies to 17 pay membership fees for Commission members or employees of the 18 Commission in applicable regional or national tax associations, dues 19 for membership in professional organizations, and registration costs 20 related to virtual or in-person continuing education to comply with 21 mandatory annual hour requirements for Commission members or 22 employees of the Commission who are certified public accountants or 23 licensed attorneys as the Commission deems in the best interest of 24

4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
