9	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE
10	An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-115, as amended by Section 55,
11	Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 6-115), which relates to expiration and renewal of
12	driver licenses; requiring persons of a certain age be issued an eight-year driver license; amending 47
13	O.S. 2021, Section 6-124, as amended by Section 63, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
14	6-124), which relates to issuance of license or identification card to veterans; requiring certain
15	disabled veterans' disability rating be notated on driver licenses or identification cards; allowing for
16	spouses and unremarried surviving spouses of certain veterans to receive disability rating or veteran
17	status notation on driver licenses or identification cards; requiring notation be accepted as proof of
18	sales tax exemption and veterans benefits; requiring certain registration to receive notations; requiring
19	implementation of certain information exchange process by certain date; requiring compliance with
20	certain standards for certain licenses; directing Service Oklahoma to seek certain federal approval;
21	providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
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24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-115, as
 amended by Section 55, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
 Section 6-115), is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-115. A. Except as otherwise provided in this
section, every driver license shall be issued for a period of either
four (4) years or eight (8) years; provided, if the applicant or
licensee is an alien, the license shall be issued for a period which
does not exceed the lesser of:

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1. Four (4) years or eight (8) years; or

10 2. The expiration date on the valid documentation authorizing 11 the presence of the applicant or licensee in the United States, as 12 required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of Section 6-103 of this 13 title.

B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration date of an initial license shall be no more than either four (4) years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of issuance or no more than either four (4) years or eight (8) years from the last day of the birth month of the applicant immediately preceding the date of issuance, if requested by the applicant.

20 C. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the expiration21 date of a renewal license shall be:

1. For a renewal during the month of expiration, either four
(4) years or eight (8) years from the last day of the month of
expiration of the expiring license or either four (4) or eight (8)

1 years from the last day of the birth month of the licensee 2 immediately preceding the expiration date of the expiring license, 3 if requested by the licensee; or

4 2. For a renewal prior to the month of expiration, as provided
5 by rule of Service Oklahoma, either four (4) or eight (8) years from
6 the last day of the month of expiration of the current license;
7 provided, no license shall be issued with an expiration date of more
8 than five (5) years from the date of renewal on a four (4) year
9 license or nine (9) years from the date of renewal on an eight (8)
10 year license.

D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection E of Section 12 1550.42 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, any Oklahoma driver 13 license that is not more than one (1) year past the date of 14 expiration provided on the driver license shall be presumed to be a 15 valid form of identification for the purposes of renewing an 16 Oklahoma driver license.

17 Ε. Except as otherwise provided in this section, every driver 18 license shall be renewable by the licensee upon application to 19 either Service Oklahoma or a licensed operator, furnishing the 20 current mailing address of the person and payment of the required 21 fee, if the person is otherwise eligible for renewal. If the 22 licensee is an alien, the licensee shall appear before a driver 23 license examiner of Service Oklahoma and shall be issued a renewal 24 driver license for a period which does not exceed the lesser of:

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1. Four (4) years or eight (8) years; or

The expiration date on the valid documentation authorizing
 the presence of the applicant or licensee in the United States, as
 required by paragraph 9 of subsection A of Section 6-103 of this
 title.

F. All applicants for renewals of driver licenses who have
proven collision records or apparent physical defects may be
required to take an examination as specified by Service Oklahoma.

9 G. When a person makes application for a driver license, or 10 makes application to renew a driver license, and the person has been 11 convicted of, or received a deferred judgment for, any offense 12 required to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act, 13 the driver license shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from 14 the month of issuance, but may be renewed yearly during the time the 15 person is registered on the Sex Offender Registry. Notwithstanding 16 any other provision of law, the cost for such license shall be the 17 same as for other driver licenses and renewals.

H. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules prescribing forms of
identification acceptable for the renewal of an Oklahoma driver
license.

21 <u>I. All driver licenses issued to persons sixty-five (65) years</u> 22 <u>of age or older shall be issued for a period of eight (8) years.</u> 23

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 SECTION 2.
 AMENDATORY
 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-124, as

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 amended by Section 63, Chapter 282, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,

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 Section 6-124), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 6-124. A. As a way to honor and recognize the veterans 5 who have served our country, Service Oklahoma shall make space 6 available in the upper left-hand corner of the front of the driver 7 license and the identification card for a flag emblem and the word "veteran" to. Similarly, when applicable, Service Oklahoma shall, 8 9 either on the front or back of the driver license or the 10 identification card, include a numeric designation indicating a 11 veteran's one-hundred-percent disability rating granted to the 12 veteran by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. The 13 items required by this subsection shall be designed by Service 14 Oklahoma that will serve as a notation of veteran status as well as 15 a notation of the existence of a United States Department of 16 Veterans Affairs disability rating as applicable. The current 17 spouse of a one-hundred-percent disabled veteran or an unremarried 18 surviving spouse of a deceased, one-hundred-percent disabled veteran 19 shall be entitled to receive a driver license or identification card 20 indicating his or her status as an eligible current spouse or an 21 eligible unremarried surviving spouse entitled to the sales tax 22 exemption provided in Section 1357 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma 23 Statutes. Representation of veteran status and disability rating on 24 the driver license and the identification card shall be adequate

1 <u>confirmation for purposes of veterans benefits offered by public or</u> 2 <u>private entities doing business within this state and no further</u> 3 <u>documentation shall be required except as specifically mandated by</u> 4 federal law.

5 Β. Upon application for issuance or renewal of the driver 6 license or identification card and in addition to other 7 documentation required by Service Oklahoma, persons requesting the 8 flag emblem or the flag emblem and the disability notation shall be 9 registered with the veterans registry Oklahoma Veterans Registry 10 created by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Provided, 11 that if the person requesting the flag emblem has previously 12 received a flag emblem pursuant to this subsection, no registration 13 with the veterans registry shall be required to receive the flag 14 emblem prior to the deadline established in subsection C of this 15 section. 16 C. Service Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Department of Veterans 17 Affairs shall implement a technology-based information exchange 18 process whereby all motor license agents are able to validate, upon 19 application for issuance or renewal of the driver license or

20 identification card, an applicant's claim of veteran status, veteran

21 disability status, status as a current spouse of an eligible,

22 disabled veteran or status as an unremarried surviving spouse of an

23 eligible, deceased disabled veteran as provided for in subsection A

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1	of this section. The requirements of this subsection shall be
2	implemented no later than July 1, 2024.
3	D. With regard to the issuance of REAL-ID compliant licenses
4	containing items described in subsection A of this section, Service
5	Oklahoma shall comply with all federal design requirements and shall
6	seek design approval from all necessary federal agencies, including
7	but not limited to the United States Department of Homeland
8	Security.
9	E. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate any rule necessary to
10	implement the provisions of this section.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
12	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
