12	A Concurrent Resolution declaring 2024 as the Year of
13	the Bible in Oklahoma; recognizing the unique contribution the Bible has made in shaping the United
14	States; acknowledging that biblical teachings inspired concepts contained in the Declaration of
15	Independence and the Constitution of the United States; recognizing that many presidents paid tribute
16	to the influence of the Bible; and stating that a renewal of knowledge and faith in God through
17	scripture can strengthen the state.

20	WHEREAS, President Ronald Reagan declared 1983 the Year of the
21	Bible; and
22	WHEREAS, the Bible, the Word of God, has made a unique
23	contribution in shaping the United States as a distinctive and
24	blessed nation and people; and

WHEREAS, deeply held religious convictions springing from the
 Holy Scriptures led to the early settlement of our nation; and

3 WHEREAS, Biblical teachings inspired concepts of civil 4 government that are contained in our Declaration of Independence and 5 the Constitution of the United States; and

6 WHEREAS, many of our great national leaders, among them 7 Presidents Washington, Jackson, Lincoln, and Wilson, have paid 8 tribute to the surpassing influence of the Bible in our country's 9 development, and in the words of President Jackson, the Bible is 10 "the rock on which our Republic rests"; and

WHEREAS, the history of our nation clearly illustrates the value of voluntarily applying the teachings of the Holy Scriptures in the lives of individuals, families, and societies; and

14 WHEREAS, this state and nation now face great challenges that 15 will test us as we have never been tested before; and

16 WHEREAS, renewing our knowledge of and faith in God through the 17 Holy Scriptures can strengthen us as a state, a nation, and a 18 people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby authorizes and requests the Governor, Executive branch, and all subdivisions of this state to designate 2024 as the Year of the Bible in the State of Oklahoma in
