12 A Concurrent Resolution relating to daylight saving
13 time; declaring support for the Sunshine Protection
14 Act of 2023; and directing distribution.

16 WHEREAS, the Sunshine Protection Act of 2023 is before the
17 consideration of the United States Congress, which would lock the
18 clock on daylight saving time permanently; and

19 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature has proposed legislation with
20 intent to observe daylight saving time year-round in this state; and

21 WHEREAS, the observation of daylight saving time has been shown
22 to have a positive impact on physical and mental health, the
23 economy, and agriculture; and

1 WHEREAS, a reduction in crime and an increase in safety to
2 communities correlates with the months daylight saving time is
3 observed.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
5 OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
6 CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature supports locking the clock on
8 daylight saving time permanently.

9 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature urges the Oklahoma Congressional
10 Delegation to support H.R.1279 and S.582 of the 118th United States
11 Congress.

12 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the entire
13 Oklahoma Congressional Delegation.
