13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 412, O.S.L.
14	2022 (69 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 4040), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 4040. A. There is hereby created until June 30, 2027,
17	the Oklahoma Route 66 Commission. The Commission shall be composed
18	of nine (9) members. The members shall serve as follows:
19	1. One Five member members shall be appointed by the Governor
20	and of which:
21	a. <u>one shall be</u> selected from the Commissioners of the
22	Oklahoma Tax Commission, whose first term shall be for
23	one (1) year, and then renewable for three-year terms
24	thereafter;

- one shall be the Executive Director of the Oklahoma 2 b. Department of Transportation, or his or her designee, 3 whose first term shall be for two (2) years, and then 4 5 renewable for three-year terms thereafter; 6 3. Tourism and Recreation Department, or his or her 8 9 designee, whose first term shall be for three (3) 10 years, and then renewable for three-year terms thereafter; 11 12 d. one shall be an Oklahoma citizen with expertise or experience in historic preservation, whose first term 13 shall be for three (3) years, and then renewable for 14 15 three-year terms thereafter, and one shall be an Oklahoma citizen with expertise or 16 e. experience in marketing, whose first term shall be for 17 three (3) years, and then renewable for three-year 18 terms thereafter. 19

14	a. one shall be a citizen of a county containing a
15	portion of Route 66, whose first term shall be for one
16	(1) year, and then renewable for three-year terms
17	thereafter,
18	b. one of whom shall be a business owner whose business
19	is located along Route 66 within a city or town whose
20	population is less than ten thousand (10,000), whose
21	first term shall be for two (2) years, and then
22	renewable for three-year terms thereafter, and.
23	c. one shall be an Oklahoma citizen with expertise or
24	experience in marketing, whose first term shall be for

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1	three (3) years, and then renewable for three-year
2	terms thereafter.
3	B. The Commission shall utilize the Oklahoma Route 66
4	Commission Revolving Fund as authorized in Section $\frac{2}{4041}$ of this
5	act <u>title</u> .
6	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
