9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Corporation
10 Commission; requiring courier application services
11 and restaurants have certain agreement; allowing for
12 filing of certain complaint; requiring Oklahoma
Corporation Commission follow certain protocol and
fee schedule; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1076 of Title 47, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Every courier application service, as defined in Section 1071 of
20 Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall have an agreement with a
21 restaurant in order to transport for delivery. If no agreement is
22 in place, the restaurant may file a complaint with the Consumer
23 Services Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission. The

1 Commission shall follow the current protocol and fine schedule for
2 violations of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
