NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 15-110 of Title 70, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 When a school district board of education calls an election 20 Α. for the purpose of issuing bonds pursuant to Section 15-102 of Title 21 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the school district shall, at least 22 thirty (30) days prior to the election, post on its website a copy 23

of the bond proposal, including each project to be funded by the

1 bond proceeds, a description of each project, and the estimated cost for each project. If electors approve the issuing of bonds at an election, the 3 В. school district shall continue to post on its website the bond 4 5 information required by subsection A of this section for the duration of the bond and one year after completion of all bond 6 projects. The information posted on the school district website 7 shall also include updates when there is a material change in the 9 scope of the projects and their purpose as stated at the time the board of education calls the bond election. The updated information 10 shall be posted online within thirty (30) days following approval of 11 12 the project changes by the board of education. 13 C. This act shall not apply to any bond projects approved by electors prior to the effective date of this act. 14 SECTION 2.
