19	1. "Food" means unserved perishable, salvageable food that has
20	been properly preserved for human consumption; and
21	2. "Restaurant" means any eating establishment regardless of
22	seating capacity including public school district cafeterias.
23	B. Any restaurant that, in good faith and without compensation,
24	donates food which is prepared and subsequently donated by the

1	restaurant shall not be liable for damages caused by the condition
2	of the food, unless the damages by the restaurant result from an

7	after November 1, 2023.
