9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5071 of Title 63, unless there 11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall establish and maintain 13 for providers of Medicaid services:

A provider enrollment and credentialing process for
 providers who receive fee-for-service reimbursement under the state
 Medicaid program; and

A single consolidated provider enrollment and credentialing
 process, in accordance with subsection D of Section 4002.4 of Title
 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes and 42 C.F.R., Section 438.214, for
 providers who enter into capitated contracts with contracted
 entities under the Ensuring Access to Medicaid Act.
 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
