14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:					
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1135.2, as					
16	amended by Section 2, Chapter 397, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,					
17	Section 1135.2), is amended to read as follows:					
18	Section 1135.2 A. Service Oklahoma is hereby authorized to					
19	design and issue appropriate official special license plates to					
20	persons in recognition of their service or awards as provided by					
21	this section.					
22	Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other					
23	person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of					
24	ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used					

on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
 registered for the current year.

Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service 3 Oklahoma or a licensed operator. Service Oklahoma shall annually 4 5 notify by mail all persons issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain 6 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a 7 licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The license plates shall be 8 9 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and 10 amateur radio operator license plates.

Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 11 12 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept applications for special license plates authorized under this 13 The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's section. 14 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 15 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 16 information directly into such system and generate a receipt 17 accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 18 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 19 registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for 20 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1, 22 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and 23

renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement
 Fund.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as 4 follows:

5 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 6 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war 7 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification 8 9 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war 10 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving 11 12 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by 13 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war 14 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one 15 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 16 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 17 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 18 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title; 19

National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4. United States Armed Forces License Plates - such plates 6 shall be designed for active, retired, former or reserve members of 7 the United States Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of 8 9 service, and carry the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to 10 which the member belongs or did belong. Former members who have 11 12 been dishonorably discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of present 13 or past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services 14 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form 15 (DD)214. Retired or former members who are eligible for such plates 16 shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but 17 shall not be required to provide proof of eligibility annually; 18

19 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such 20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been 21 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply 22 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each 23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 24 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are 2 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse 3 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is 4 5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon 6 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action 7 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse 8 9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each 10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity 11 12 of one (1) ton or less;

7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be 13 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper 14 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs 15 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such 16 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration. 17 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate 18 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or 19 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been 20 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not 21 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated 22 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one 23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. 24 The

 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
 States as being:

- a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
 of 1945,

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall 7 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and 8 9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the 10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB." at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. 11 Such 12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the 13 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of 14 registration after the initial issue; 15

Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for

9 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were 10 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse 11 12 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action 13 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person 14 was killed in action and that the person making the application is 15 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse 16 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two 17 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) 18 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special 19 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to 20 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration 21 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Beginning November 1, 22 2021, the killed in action license plate shall be designed to honor 23 members of the United States Armed Forces who were killed in action 24

the deceased person. The family member may apply for a gold star families license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

8 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be 9 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the 10 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the 11 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or 12 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a 13 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated 14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

15 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 16 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United 17 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such 18 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each 19 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

20 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be 21 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal 22 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police 23 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and 24 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council

1 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may 2 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of 3 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common 4 5 education police department by either an identification card or letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma 6 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for 7 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial 8 9 application but shall not be required to provide proof of 10 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with municipal police departments of this state; 11 12 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in 13 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate; 14 World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be 15 16. designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United 16 17 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be verified by the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the 18 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United 19 States as having served on federal active duty anytime during the 20 period from September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former 21 members may apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for 22

vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

The special license plate may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been registered for the current year with a licensed operator.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by Service 19 Oklahoma or a licensed operator, unless authorized by Service 20 Oklahoma to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year. 21 Service Oklahoma shall notify by mail all persons issued special 22 license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary information 23 and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure upon

presentation to a licensed operator or Service Oklahoma. The
 license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

Service Oklahoma is hereby directed to develop and implement a 3 system whereby licensed operators are permitted to accept 4 5 applications for special license plates authorized under this section. The licensed operator shall confirm the applicant's 6 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount 7 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary 8 9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, licensed operators 10 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for 11 12 registration of a motor vehicle. The licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the 13 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund. Beginning January 1, 14 2023, the licensed operator fees for acceptance of applications and 15 renewals shall be paid out of the Service Oklahoma Reimbursement 16 Fund. 17

18 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates 19 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1, 20 2006, Service Oklahoma shall discontinue issuance and renewal of 21 that type of special license plate.
