15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.15 of Title 70, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. A school district may offer to students in grades eleven and
20	twelve an elective course in law enforcement.
21	B. The law enforcement elective course shall include, at a
22	minimum:
23	1. A general introduction to law enforcement training;

1	2. Critical skills and entry requirements for law enforcement
2	professionals; and
3	3. Career opportunities in law enforcement.
4	C. The State Board of Education may coordinate with the Council
5	on Law Enforcement Education and Training to develop instructional
6	materials and curricula for school districts to use in the law
7	enforcement elective course. The Board may promulgate rules to
8	implement the provisions of this section.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
