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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1000.2, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1000.2 A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby
19	re-created to continue until July 1, <del>2023</del> 2026, in accordance with
20	the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate
21	the plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and
22	construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the
23	powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act

 trades, or as otherwise provided by law.

B. 1. Beginning July 1, 2013, the Board shall be composed of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Oklahoma State Senate, as follows:

- a. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
  experience in the plumbing trade, of which one shall
  be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a journeyman
  plumber,
- b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
  experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall
  be an electrical contractor and one shall be a
  journeyman electrician,
- 14 c. two members shall have at least ten (10) years' 15 experience in the mechanical trade, of which one shall 16 be a mechanical contractor and one shall be a 17 mechanical journeyman, and
- 18 d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years'
   19 experience as a building and construction inspector.

20 2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4) 21 years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in 22 office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor 23 shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as

2	filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.
