14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.9 of Title 63, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
19	Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3420.10 of Title 63, unless
22	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	There is hereby created the Adolescent Psychiatric Facility
24	Grant Program which shall be administered by the Department of

1 Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. The program shall help 2 increase the number of adolescent psychiatric beds available in Oklahoma. The program shall help provide funding for remodeling or 3 building out existing facility space to be used for an adolescent 4 5 psychiatric facility. The program shall be used for facilities where a Public Trust Hospital, as defined in Sections 3250.1 through 6 3250.9 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, are donating both the 7 space and the staffing needs to support the facility. Applicants 9 shall have, in writing, the agreed upon support from the donating 10 Public Trust Hospital upon application. The location of these facilities shall be in counties with a population of less than 11 forty-five thousand (45,000) people per the 2020 Federal Decennial 12 Census. The facility, upon completion, shall hold between ten and 13 twenty beds for adolescent psychiatric patients upon completion. 14 Beginning January 1, 2025, the Department of Mental Health and 15 Substance Abuse Services shall provide an annual report to the 16 Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the 17 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the 18 Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of 19 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the State Senate 20 that includes information about any grants awarded and where 21 awardees are on the completion of the projects. 22

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SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3240.11 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to be designated the "Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services from appropriations to the fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the purpose of the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services may retain one percent (1%) of all funds otherwise deposited to the fund to cover administrative costs related to the Oklahoma Adolescent Psychiatric Facility Grant Program. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
