11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 214, O.S.L.
13	2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 1-133.1a), is amended to read as
14	follows:
15	Section 1-133.1a Military surplus vehicle.
16	A. A "military surplus vehicle" is any motor vehicle having:
17	1. Three axles or fewer that meet the legal size and weight
18	limits set forth in Section 14-103 of <del>Title 47 of the Oklahoma</del>
19	Statutes this title;
20	2. An age less than thirty-five (35) years old and was Been
21	manufactured for use in either the United States Armed Forces or any
22	country that was a member of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization
23	at the time the vehicle was manufactured. Such vehicle shall have
24	

1	been subsequently authorized for sale to civilians, except that
2	military surplus vehicle does not include a tracked vehicle;
3	3. For each occupant, safety belts or safety shoulder harnesses
4	which shall be installed pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Section 571.208 et
5	seq.; and
6	4. Equipment required by the provisions of Sections 12-201
7	through 12-232 of <del>Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes</del> this title, with
8	respect to equipment on vehicles.
9	B. A military surplus vehicle that is less than thirty-five
10	(35) years of age and is operated on the streets and highways of
11	this state shall be registered as a motor vehicle. Beginning
12	November 1, 2024, any military surplus vehicle operated on the
13	streets and highways of this state shall be registered as a motor
14	vehicle.
15	C. Military surplus vehicles may be used as other vehicles of
16	the same type, except military surplus vehicles may not transport
17	people for hire.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
