BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Barbara Weber
Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program which shall be administered by the State Department of Health. The program shall grant funds to

1 support research, being conducted in Oklahoma, for Amyotrophic
2 Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) and for programs that help support Oklahoma
3 residents caring for a family member afflicted with ALS. Beginning
4 July 1, 2025, the State Department of Health shall provide an annual
5 report to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
6 Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
7 Senate, Appropriations and Budget Chair of the Oklahoma House of
8 Representatives, and the Appropriations Chair of the Oklahoma State
9 Senate that includes, but is not limited to, how many grants have
10 been awarded during the Fiscal Year, which entities the grants have
11 been awarded to, and for what purposes the funds are supporting.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-580.2 of Title 63, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 There is hereby created in the Oklahoma State Treasury a
16 revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated
17 the "Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program
18 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
19 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
20 by the State Department of Health from appropriations, donations,
21 grants, or other sources of funding specifically designated for
22 deposit to the Barbara Weber Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
23 Grant Program Revolving Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of
24 said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended

1 by the State Department of Health for the purpose of Barbara Weber
2 Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS) Grant Program. Expenditures
3 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
4 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
5 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
6 approval and payment.

7 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

8 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
