9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.431 of Title 69, unless 11 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge on State Highway 31 crossing over Turkey Creek east 13 of Lequire in Haskell County shall be designated as the "C.B. and 14 Lois Craft Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall 15 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on 16 the bridge. 17

SECTION 3.
