The Office shall serve as a point of contact to assist businesses operating for five (5) years or less in their interactions with state government.

C. No later than January 1, 2024, and annually thereafter, the
Office shall prepare an annual report detailing the extent to which
state legislation that has been signed by the Governor in the prior
legislative session or year supports, hinders, or otherwise affects
businesses operating for five (5) years or less.

D. The Office shall support and advise the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce with preparing the report pursuant to Section 3 of this act.

14 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5003.16.2 of Title 74, unless 16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No later than January 1, 2024, and annually thereafter, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall file a report with the Legislature that includes, but is not limited to:

The number and total dollar amount of state contracts
 awarded to businesses that have been in operation for less than five
 (5) years, including a breakdown by demographic segments and
 geographic areas throughout the state;

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2. The percentage of the number of state contracts awarded to
 businesses that have been in operation for less than five (5) years
 compared to the total number of contracts awarded; and

3. The percentage of the total dollar amount of state contracts
awarded to businesses that have been in operation for less than five
(5) years compared to the total dollar amount of contracts awarded.

B. The Director shall produce and file a report with the Legislature making recommendations on improving access to state contracts for businesses that have been in operation for less than five (5) years, including those businesses in statistically underrepresented demographic segments and geographic areas of the state.

13 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5003.16.3 of Title 74, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

After the effective date of this act, the Legislature shall encourage five percent (5%) of the total number of state contracts to be awarded to businesses that have been in operation for less than five (5) years and whose principal place of business is in the state.

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1 After the effective date of this act, the Legislature shall encourage five percent (5%) of funding budgeted for economic 2 development programs, including Community Development Block Grants, 3 to be allocated to supporting organizations and programs for 4 5 individuals starting new businesses or to those organizations or programs that provide services to businesses established within the 6 previous five (5) years and whose principal place of business is in 7 this state. 8

9 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5003.16.8 of Title 74, unless 10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 11 12 After the effective date of this act, the Legislature shall encourage the elimination of all first-year business fees relating 13

to any license or registration, for any new business or a person 14 establishing a new business, including home-based businesses, whose 15 principal place of business is in this state. 16
