SENATE BILL NO. 1197

An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge designations; designating the Col. John L. Smith Medal of Honor Recipient Memorial Highway; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.431 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 77 beginning on the east side of the James C. Nance Bridge extending through the town of Lexington to the intersection of Moffatt Road in Cleveland County shall be designated as the "Col. John L. Smith Medal of Honor Recipient Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
