8	An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 2305, which relates to
9	the Advisory Committee on Pedorthics; extending
10	sunset date; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 2305, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2305. A. There is hereby re-created, to continue until
17	July 1, 2024 July 1, 2027, in accordance with the provisions of the
18	Oklahoma Sunset Law, an Advisory Committee on Pedorthics, which
19	shall consist of five (5) voting members to be appointed by the
20	State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision to three-year terms
21	ending December 31; provided, initial appointments shall be
22	staggered such that two members are appointed for one (1) year, two
23	members are appointed for two (2) years, and one member is appointed
24	for three (3) years.

B. One member shall be a licensed physician who is a member of
the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. One member
shall be a physician licensed to practice podiatric medicine by the
Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners. One member shall be a member
of the public who is a consumer of pedorthic services. Two members
shall be pedorthists certified by the Board for Certification in
Pedorthics or pedorthists licensed by the State Board of Medical
Licensure and Supervision.

- C. Members shall serve until their successors are appointed and qualified; provided, no member shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive years or two full terms, whichever is greater.
- D. The Committee shall annually elect a chair and vice-chair vice chair from among the members. The chair or vice-chair vice chair and two other members shall constitute a quorum. Members shall be reimbursed from funds available to the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
- E. 1. The Committee shall advise the Board on matters pertaining to pedorthics, including but not limited to:
 - a. scope and standards of practice,
 - b. licensure and registration requirements, examination requirements, exceptions thereto, renewal requirements, temporary licensure or registration, and endorsement or reciprocity requirements,

1	c. methods and requirements for ensuring the continued
2	competence of licensed and registered persons,
3	d. grounds for probation, revocation or suspension of
4	license or registration, reinstatement provisions,
5	e. fees, and
6	f. all other matters which may pertain to the practice of
7	pedorthics.
8	2. The Committee shall review and make recommendations to the
9	Board on all applications for licensure and registration.
10	3. The Committee shall assist and advise the Board in all
11	hearings related to the enforcement of the Oklahoma Licensed
12	Pedorthists Act.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
14	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
