NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-3-404 of Title 27A, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving 17 fund for the Department of Environmental Quality to be designated 18 the "Blue River-Little Blue Creek Stream Health Assessment Study 19 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject 20 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received 21 by the Department from appropriations, apportionments, donations, 22 and federal grants received for the purpose of completing the study 23 created pursuant to subsection B of this section. All monies 24

accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose provided
for in this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and

Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

- Pursuant to the requirements of Section 1-3-101 of Title 27A В. of the Oklahoma Statutes as it relates to waters emanating from a 9 sensitive sole source aquifer, the Department shall establish and perform a Blue River-Little Blue Creek Stream Health Assessment 10 Study. The Department shall coordinate with the Center for 11 12 Reservoir and Aquatic Systems Research at Baylor University for the purpose of defining the study scope and conducting the work 13 necessary to complete data collection and the development of the 14 Blue River-Little Blue Creek Stream Health Assessment Study. 15 Department may coordinate with other relevant state and federal 16 agencies to effectuate the provisions of this section. 17
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
