SENATE BILL NO. 1340

An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney General; creating the Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund; specifying source of fund; providing for expenditures; providing purpose of fund; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 30.9 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Office of the Attorney General to be designated the "Federal Overreach and Extraordinary Litigation Revolving Fund". This fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Office of the Attorney General from legislative appropriations provided for the purpose of representing the State of Oklahoma in cases of fighting

1 federal overreach in Oklahoma, pursuant to Enrolled House Bill No.
2 1236 of the 1st Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature,
3 extraordinary litigation costs, foreign threats, interstate crime,
4 terrorist organizations, gross violations of public trust, and
5 statewide public safety. All monies accruing to the credit of the
6 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
7 Office of the Attorney General for the purpose provided by this
8 section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
9 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
10 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
11 Services for approval and payment.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
