13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1835, as
14	amended by Section 2, Chapter 159, O.S.L. 2023 (21 O.S. Supp. 2023,
15	Section 1835), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1835. A. Whoever shall willfully or maliciously
17	knowingly enter the garden, yard, pasture, or field of another after
18	being expressly forbidden to do so or without permission by the
19	owner or lawful occupant thereof, or a person failing to leave
20	lodging establishment premises pursuant to Section 508 of Title 15
21	of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall <u>upon conviction</u> be deemed guilty of
22	trespass and upon conviction shall be punished <u>punishable</u> by a fine
23	of not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that
24	this. Such provision shall not apply to registered land surveyors

1	and registered professional engineers for the purpose of land
2	surveying in the performance of their professional services; and,
3	provided further, that anyone. Any person who willfully or

B. E. Anyone who willfully or maliciously knowingly enters any such land of another and commits or attempts to commit waste, theft, or damage shall <u>upon conviction</u> be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished punishable by:

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C. <u>F.</u> No provisions of this section shall be construed to

D. G. Whoever shall willfully enter the pecan grove of another 4 5 without the prior consent of the owner or occupant thereof to so do shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of trespass and upon 6 conviction shall be punished punishable by a fine of not more than 7 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00); provided, that anyone. Any person who 8 9 willfully enters any such pecan grove and therein commits or 10 attempts to commit waste, theft, or damage shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished 11 12 punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than 13 six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. 14

E. H. Whoever shall willfully or maliciously enter upon 15 property owned or managed by the Grand River Dam Authority without 16 permission shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of misdemeanor 17 trespass and upon conviction shall be punished punishable by a fine 18 of not more than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00); provided, that 19 this. Such provision shall not apply to registered land surveyors 20 and registered professional engineers for the purpose of land 21 surveying in the performance of their professional services; and, 22 provided further, that anyone. Any person who willfully or 23 maliciously enters upon property owned or managed by the Grand River 24

F. I. Any person who shall willfully or maliciously enter the 8 9 grounds of the Governor's Mansion within the State Capitol Park, as defined in Section 1811.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, 10 except at a place where entry to the property is normally expected, 11 12 shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished punishable by a fine of not more than 13 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the county 14 jail for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) 15 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. 16
