17	B. The Division shall:
18	1. Operate and maintain an <del>on-line</del> <u>online</u> , realtime computer
19	system and a statewide law enforcement data communication network;
20	2. Utilize and distribute information on vehicle registration,
21	driver records, criminals and the commission of crimes;
22	3. Be responsible for the coordination of user agencies with
23	the National Crime Information Center in Washington, D.C., and the
24	National Law Enforcement Telecommunication System, or its successor;

<u>state's</u> input, retrieval, and exchange of law enforcement
information in the National Crime Information Center and the

5 5. Provide user agencies a data communication network, in order 6 to exchange and distribute law enforcement data rapidly, and 7 training in the use of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement 8 Telecommunication Systems.

9 C. The statewide law enforcement data communications network shall be a part of the Oklahoma Government Telecommunications 10 Network (OGTN) created in Section 34.23 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma 11 12 Statutes; provided, however, the Department of Public Safety may continue to operate, maintain, and enhance the statewide law 13 enforcement data communications network; provided, however, the 14 Department of Public Safety shall submit all plans for the 15 enhancement of the statewide law enforcement communications network 16 to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for review and 17 approval. The Department of Public Safety shall participate with 18 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in joint efforts to 19 provide services for the OGTN. 20

D. All criminal justice agencies disseminating criminal history information derived from the National Crime Information Center's criminal history file shall maintain a record of dissemination in accordance with federal law as well as rules promulgated by the

National Crime Information Center and the Commissioner of Public
Safety.

The Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication Systems 3 Ε. 4 Division shall have the authority to audit state and local law 5 enforcement and criminal justice agencies to ensure compliance with federal laws as well as rules of the Department of Public Safety 6 which pertain to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication 7 Systems. 8 9 F. The Department of Public Safety may provide the Oklahoma 10 Turnpike Authority vehicle registration information within this 11 state that is available through the Oklahoma Law Enforcement 12 Telecommunication Systems network for purposes of the operation of 13 toll transportation facilities.
