15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 180.91 of Title 19, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	The board of county commissioners may develop a policy in
19	accordance with the secretary of the county election board to
20	authorize county employees to receive up to three (3) working days'
21	paid administrative leave per calendar year for the purpose of
22	serving as a precinct official pursuant to Section 2-124 of Title 26
23	of the Oklahoma Statutes, absentee voting board member pursuant to
24	Section 14-115.5 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or other

election worker authorized by law, if the employee is qualified to serve in such position. SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
