12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 14-137, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	As used in the Uniform Military and Overseas Voters Act:
16	1. "Covered voter" means:
17	a. a uniformed-service voter or an overseas voter who is
18	registered to vote in this state,
19	b. a uniformed-service voter defined in subparagraph a of
20	paragraph 9 of this section, whose voting residence is
21	in this state and who otherwise satisfies this state's
22	voter eligibility requirements,
23	c. an overseas voter who, before leaving the United
24	States, was last eligible to vote in this state and,

- 3. "Federal postcard application" means the application prescribed under Section 101(b)(2) of the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 1973ff(b)(2);
- 4. "Federal write-in absentee ballot" means the ballot described in Section 103 of the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 1973ff-2;
  - 5. "Military-overseas ballot" means:
    - a. a federal write-in absentee ballot,
    - a ballot specifically prepared or distributed for use
       by a covered voter in accordance with this act Section
       14-136 et seq. of this title, or
    - c. a ballot cast by a covered voter in accordance with this act the Uniform Military and Overseas Voters Act;
- 6. "Overseas voter" means a United States citizen who is outside the United States;
- 7. "State" means a state of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the United States Virgin Islands, or any territory or insular possession subject to the jurisdiction of the United States;
  - 8. "Uniformed service" means:
    - a. active and reserve components of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, <u>Space Force</u>, or Coast Guard of the United States,

- the Merchant Marine Marines, the commissioned corps of 1 b. the Public Health Service, or the commissioned corps 2 of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration 3 of the United States, or 4 5 the National Guard and state militia; 9. "Uniformed-service voter" means an individual who is 6 qualified to vote and is: 7 a member of the active or reserve components of the 8 9 Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, or Coast Guard of the United States who is on active 10 11 duty, 12 b. a member of the Merchant Marine Marines, the commissioned corps of the Public Health Service, or 13 the commissioned corps of the National Oceanic and 14 Atmospheric Administration of the United States, 15 a member on activated status of the National Guard or 16 C. state militia, or 17 a spouse or dependent of a member referred to in this 18 d. paragraph; and 19 "United States", used in the territorial sense, means the 20 21

1	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2021, Section 2, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	The words "ex-service person", "veteran", or "war veteran" used
4	in this act Section 1 et seq. of this title shall be construed to
5	mean any person who:
6	1. Has served the full obligation for active duty, Reserve or
7	National Guard service in the military uniformed service as defined
8	in Section 14-137 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or received
9	an early discharge for a medical condition, hardship, or reduction
10	in force; and
11	2. Has been separated or discharged from such service honorably
12	or under honorable conditions.
13	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
