10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 475.3, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 475.3. A. The State Board of Licensure for
14	Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors is hereby re-created, to
15	continue until July 1, $\frac{2023}{2026}$, in accordance with the provisions
16	of the Oklahoma Sunset Law, whose duty it shall be to administer the
17	provisions of Section 475.1 et seq. of this title. The Board shall
18	consist of four professional engineers and two professional land
19	surveyors, at least one of whom is not a professional engineer, all
20	of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and
21	consent of the Senate. The Governor shall also appoint one lay
22	member. The professional engineers and professional land surveyors
23	shall be appointed by the Governor and shall have the qualifications
24	required by Section 475.4 of this title.

B. Each member of the Board shall file with the Secretary of
State a written oath or affirmation for the faithful discharge of
official duties.

C. Appointments to the Board shall be in such manner and for 4 5 such period of time so that no two terms, with the exception of the lay member, shall expire in the same year. On the expiration of the 6 term of any member, except the lay member, the Governor shall in the 7 manner herein provided appoint for a term of six (6) years a 8 9 professional engineer or professional land surveyor having the qualifications required in Section 475.4 of this title. The lay 10 member of the Board shall be appointed by the Governor to a term 11 12 coterminous with that of the Governor. The lay member shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. Provided, the lay member may 13 continue to serve after the expiration of the member's term until 14 such time as a successor is appointed. Members may be reappointed 15 to succeed themselves. Each member may hold office until the 16 expiration of the term for which appointed or until a successor has 17 been duly appointed and has qualified. In the event of a vacancy on 18 the Board due to resignation, death or for any cause resulting in an 19 unexpired term, if not filled within three (3) months, the Board may 20 appoint a provisional member to serve in the interim until the 21 Governor acts. 22

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
