An Act relating to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous  
Substances Act; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 2-322,  
which relates to precursor substances requiring  
permit or license; removing certain drugs from  
requiring certain permitting or licensing; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 2-322, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 2-322. A. No person or business shall possess, sell,  
manufacture, transfer, or otherwise furnish any of the following  
precursor substances without first having a permit or license issued  
by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and  
Dangerous Drugs Control, except as provided in Section 2-327 of this  
title:

1. D-Lysergic acid;
2. Ergotamine and its salts;
3. Ergonovine and its salts;
4. Methylamine;

- 2        6. Phenyl-2-Propanone;
- 3        7. Phenylacetic acid and its salts;
- 4        8. ~~Ephedrine, its salts, optical isomers and salts of optical~~

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1       B. Upon completion of an application for a license pursuant to  
2 Section 2-323 of this title, or a permit pursuant to Section 2-324  
3 of this title, the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
4 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall either grant or deny  
5 such license or permit. A denial of an application for a permit or  
6 license shall be handled as provided by Section 2-325 of this title.

7       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
