12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 353.1c of Title 59, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A pharmacist licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy may, in
16	accordance with state and federal laws and rules, prescribe
17	nonprescription drugs for the purposes of extemporaneous compounding
18	or compounding for a known patient need in the practice area. The
19	Board may promulgate rules to implement this section.
20	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
