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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 500 of Title 53, unless there is
19	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Semiquincentennial
21	Commission until June 30, 2027.
22	B. The duties of the Commission shall be as follows:
23	1. Be the point of contact for state and national organizations
24	and events related to the Semiquincentennial of the United States;

Cooperate with the United States Semiquincentennial
 Commission and various state agencies, boards, commissions,
 departments, and political subdivisions in order to execute
 commemorative events and to implement educational activities,
 events, and celebrations related to the Semiquincentennial of the
 United States.

C. The Commission shall be composed of twenty-five (25)
 members. The members shall serve as follows:

12 1. Five members appointed by the Governor as follows:

- a. one who shall be a member with experience in the study
 and documentation of the history of Latino communities
 in Oklahoma,
- b. one who shall be a member with experience in the study
 and documentation of the history of Black communities
 in Oklahoma,
- c. one who shall be a member with experience in the study
 and documentation of the history of American Indian
 communities in Oklahoma,
- d. one who shall be a current fifth-grade teacher
 currently certified to teach in Oklahoma with
 experience teaching United States history, and

1	e. one who shall be a secondary teacher currently
2	certified to teach United States history in Oklahoma;
3	2. Five members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House
4	of Representatives, one appointee from each of the five
5	congressional districts;
6	3. Five members shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore
7	of the Senate, one appointee from each of the five congressional
8	districts; and
9	4. Nine voting ex officio members shall be appointed as
10	follows:
11	a. the Lieutenant Governor, or designee, who shall serve
12	as chair,
13	b. the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Historical
14	Society, or designee, who shall serve as vice chair,
15	c. the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce,
16	or designee,
17	d. the Superintendent of Public Instruction, or designee,
18	e. the Chancellor of the State Regents for Higher
19	Education, or designee,
20	f. the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Arts Council,
21	or designee,
22	g. the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Tourism and
23	Recreation Department, or designee,

- i. the Regent of the Oklahoma Society Daughters of the
 American Revolution, and
- 3

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j. the President of the Oklahoma Society of the Sons of the American Revolution.

5 D. Commission members may be removed for cause. Whenever a 6 vacancy on the Commission occurs by death, resignation, or 7 otherwise, the appointing authority shall fill the same by 8 appointment, and the appointee shall hold office during the 9 unexpired term. Each member shall hold office until a successor has 10 been appointed.

E. All appointments to the Commission shall be made no later than August 1, 2023. The Commission shall hold its first meeting no later than September 1, 2023. The Commission shall be staffed by the Oklahoma Historical Society. All appropriate agencies of state government shall provide assistance to the Commission upon request of the Commission.

F. A quorum of thirteen members shall be required to conduct official business of the Commission. The Commission may establish subcommittees to effectuate the purpose of the Commission. The Commission shall meet as often as necessary to perform its duties.

G. Members of the Commission shall receive no compensation for serving on the Commission but shall receive travel reimbursement for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their

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duties by their respective agencies in accordance with the State
 Travel Reimbursement Act.

3	H. The Commission shall be authorized to:
4	a. employ personnel,
5	b. contract for services, and
6	c. accept gifts, grants, and donations which shall be
7	deposited into the Semiquincentennial Revolving Fund,
8	created in Section 2 of this act.
9	I. On or after June 30, 2027, any remaining supplies or
10	property of the Commission shall transfer to the Oklahoma Historical
11	Society.
12	J. No later than March 1, 2024, the Commission shall
13	electronically submit a report to the Governor, President Pro
14	Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
15	Representatives to include the following information:
16	1. Mission statement of the Commission;
17	2. Goals of the Commission;
18	3. List of proposed activities;
19	4. List of milestones along with applicable dates for executing
20	the proposed activities; and
21	5. Projected budget for planned activities and private
22	fundraising goals.
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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 501 of Title 53, unless there is
 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 4 5 for the Oklahoma Historical Society to be designated the "Semiquincentennial Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing 6 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of 7 all monies received from legislative appropriations, private 8 9 donations, gifts, and grants. All monies accruing to the credit of 10 the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Semiquincentennial Commission for the purposes of the 11 12 Commission. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 13 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 14 Services for approval and payment. The Semiquincentennial Revolving 15 Fund shall sunset on June 30, 2027. Any remaining monies in the 16 fund shall transfer to the Historical Society Revolving Fund, 17 created in Section 1.10 of Title 53 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 18

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
