SENATE BILL 1630

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public utilities; prohibiting certain entities from compelling certain actions of certain utilities; construing provision; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 158 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. No person, corporation, association, state, or other entity shall compel or coerce any public utility as defined pursuant to Section 151 of Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes to meet any rule, standard, goal, quota, or other effort to regulate or otherwise govern the production, transmission, delivery, or furnishing of electric current for light, heat, or power, or to spread or share the cost for infrastructure of generation methods located in other states.

B. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to limit the proper exercise of authority or powers of any local, state, or federal political subdivisions.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
