7	An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; defining terms; authorizing the
8	Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to develop certain procedures related
9	to requests for certain record checks; stating criteria for such requests; requiring submission of
10	fingerprints for certain determination; determining responsibility of certain entity to provide certain
11	decision; authorizing application to certain individuals and entities; providing certain
12	construction; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.9.2 of Title 74, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	A. For purposes of this section, the following terms are
20	defined as follows:
21	1. "Authorized agency" means the agency designated by statute
22	to report, receive, or disseminate a state or national criminal
23	history record check;

1 2. "Child" means a person who is a under the age of eighteen
2 (18) years;

3 3. "Care" means the provision of care, treatment, education, 4 training, instruction, supervision, or recreation to children, the 5 elderly, or individuals with disabilities;

- 4. "Covered individual" means a person who:
- 7 a. has, seeks to have, or may have access to children,
 8 the elderly, or individuals with disabilities, served
 9 by a qualified entity, and
- b. (1) is employed by or volunteers with, or seeks to be employed by or volunteer with, a qualified entity, or
- 13 (2) owns or operates, or seeks to own or operate, a 14 qualified entity;

15 5. "Employed by" means to be paid to provide or seek to provide 16 care services for a qualified entity, regardless of being paid 17 directly by the qualified entity or by an entity contracted by the 18 qualified entity to provide care;

19 6. "Individuals with disabilities" means persons with a mental 20 or physical impairment who require assistance to perform one or more 21 daily living tasks;

7. "National criminal history record check system" means the criminal history record system maintained by the Federal Bureau of lateral bureau of

Investigation (FBI) based on fingerprint identification or any other method of positive identification; and

8. "Qualified entity" means a business or organization whether public, private, for-profit, not-for-profit, or voluntary, that provides care or care placement services, including a business or organization that licenses or certifies others to provide care or care placement services.

B. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
(OSBI) shall develop procedures in accordance with the federal
National Child Protection Act of 1993 and the federal Volunteers for
Children Act to enable a qualified entity to request a state and
national criminal history record check to determine whether a
covered individual is the subject of any child abuse crime.

¹⁴ C. The request for a state and national criminal history record ¹⁵ check shall be made by:

16 1. Electronically submitting the fingerprints of the covered 17 individual to the OSBI as directed by the authorized agency; and 18 2. Submitting to the authorized agency a copy of a statement 19 signed by the covered individual that includes:

a. a waiver permitting the qualified entity to request
 and receive a criminal history record check for the
 purpose of determining the qualification and fitness
 of a person to serve as a covered individual;

- b. the name, address, and date of birth of the covered individual as it appears on a valid identification document;
- 4 a disclosure of whether the individual has ever been с. 5 convicted of or is the subject of pending charges for 6 a criminal offense and, if convicted, a description of 7 the crime and the result of the conviction; and 8 d. a notice to the individual that he or she is entitled 9 to obtain a copy of the criminal history record check 10 to verify the accuracy and completeness of any 11 information contained in such report before a 12 determination is made by the qualified entity.

13 An authorized agency shall require a qualified entity to D. 14 obtain fingerprints from a covered individual and to submit the 15 fingerprints to the OSBI and the FBI for a state and national 16 criminal history record check. The OSBI shall use the fingerprints 17 to identify the individual and to determine whether he or she has a 18 record of criminal history in this state or other jurisdictions or 19 The OSBI will provide results of the criminal history countries. 20 record check to the authorized agency. The authorized agency may 21 use the information obtained from the fingerprints and such state 22 and national criminal history record checks in the official 23 determination of the qualifications and fitness of the person to 24 serve as a covered individual. _ _

E. The authorized agency shall be solely responsible for making any determination that a criminal history record of a person shows that such person has been convicted of a crime that bears upon the fitness of such person to serve as a provider. This section does not require the OSBI to make such a determination on behalf of any authorized agency.

7 F. This section shall only apply to covered individuals and 8 qualified entities as defined in this section. This section shall 9 not be construed to replace, supersede, or in any way affect any 10 state law that requires a national criminal history record check, 11 prescribes procedures for a national criminal history record check 12 required by state law, or precludes an individual from employment 13 based on the results of a national criminal history record check 14 required by state law. 15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
