14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 250.8 of Title 74, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. No state employee shall be annually compensated more than
18	the Governor of this state pursuant to the salary established in
19	Section 250.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
20	B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section and for
21	the purposes of this section, "state employee" means and includes
22	each officer or employee elected or employed in the service of this

state.

- C. The following state employees shall be exempt from the requirements in subsection A of this section:
- 1. Officers and members of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and state employees of institutions under the administrative authority of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; and
- 2. Physicians and other licensed health care professionals under the administrative authority of any state department or agency.
- D. State employee compensation greater than the Governor's may be submitted to the Legislature by the director of the respective state department or agency. The Legislature may approve submitted compensation by the proper passage of a joint or concurrent resolution.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
