SENATE BILL 1771

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to rights-of-way; amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1208, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 335, O.S.L. 2023 (69 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 1208), which relates to the placement of structures in rights-of-way; modifying applicability of section; enabling the placement of certain signage in certain locations; updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1208, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 335, O.S.L. 2023 (69 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 1208), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1208. ~~(a)~~ A. The rights-of-way acquired by the Department of Transportation or a county shall be held inviolate for state highway, departmental, or county purposes, and no physical or functional encroachments or uses shall be permitted within such rights-of-way.

~~(b)~~ B. It shall be unlawful for any person to construct, maintain or operate any gasoline pump, driveway canopy, building, sign, fence, post, or any thing or structure on or overhanging any

1 right-of-way, or upon or overhanging any street occupied by a
2 designated state or federal highway, or county roads and the
3 construction or maintaining of any such thing or structure on or
4 overhanging any federal or state highway or county roads shall
5 constitute a public nuisance, which may be summarily abated by the
6 Commission or board of county commissioners or its officers, agents,
7 servants and employees in the manner provided in this article.

8 ~~(e)~~ C. This section shall not apply to the lawful use of such
9 rights-of-way for the erection and operation of facilities of a
10 public utility, or companies engaged in the activities defined in
11 Section 137.1 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

12 D. This section shall not apply to the placement, by the county
13 commissioners or the board of directors of a fire protection
14 district or the designees of either, of signage indicating that
15 restrictions on outdoor burning are in effect pursuant to Section
16 901.8 of Title 19 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such signage may be
17 placed on the right-of-way, provided such placement is made in
18 coordination with the Department of Transportation.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
