AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; requiring state agencies take certain action before promulgating new rule; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3503 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

No agency or entity of this state shall promulgate a new rule or regulation unless such agency or entity first repeals two (2) rules or regulations previously promulgated by such agency or entity.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
